



Adding new cords




Adding a vertical cord - Position the replacement cord behind the piece so that the long end comes out where you need to replace the cord. Secure the end of the replacement cord to the board with a pin/tape. Move the cord that needs to be replaced to the back of the piece and out of the way. Make a DHH with the new cord around the horizontal holding cord. Continue knotting the piece with the other cords.



Adding a horizontal cord with a vertical double half hitch (VDHH) Position the new replacement cord behind the piece so that

Position the new replacement cord behind the piece so that the long end comes out where you need to replace the cord. Secure the short end of the replacement cord to the board with a pin/tape. Move the cord that needs to be replaced to the back of the piece and out of the way.

Make a VDHH with the new cord around the vertical holding cord. Continue knotting the piece with the other cords.



Adding a horizontal cord with a double half hitch (DHH) -

Position the new replacement cord behind the piece so that the long end comes out where you need to replace the holding cord. Secure the short end of the replacement cord to the board with a pin/tape. Line up the original holding cord with the replacement cord. Group the old and new holding cords as one and make a DHH around the 2 joint cords. Bring the old holding cord to the back of the piece and out of the way. Continue knotting the piece using the new holding cord.
